Further to your email and our telephone conversation this afternoon I wish to confirm the following:

- 1) I am happy for you to amend my answer of no to YES regarding "protected species on land adjacent or near to the site"
- 2) The grouse butts will be a maximum of 1.8m deep and will be 1.8m wide x 1.8m long. Please note that should some of the boards project above the existing ground level due to the existing levels, these areas will be filled with material from the excavation, graded, dressed with soil and vegetated with heather to blend with the surroundings. Therefore no boards will be left protruding above ground level on completion.
- 3) I will consult with one of my colleagues who may already have photographs and forward these along with peat depth information as soon as this is to hand.

I hope this will enable validation of the application without further delay, however should you require any further details please contact me.
