The natural nests were removed after the breeding season and the netting proposed will prevent swallows and house sparrows starting nests before the building is fully enclosed. I suggested the tell tale tags to prevent entanglement and injury to birds as well as the barrier which I see is listed on the specification. The location of the bat box is satisfactory.
