15NP0050 - Notification for prior notification of forestry development: construction of 600 metre extraction road at Nanny's Hills, Wark , Hexham, Northumberland

Thank you for consulting me on the above application for the construction of a 600m forestry extraction track in the Wark Forest area of Kielder Forest.

I note from the application that all works are to be designed and built to 'Forestry Civil Engineering Specifications and Standards' but in my view it would be helpful to know which specific standards, as these do change and get updated every so often. I note that the proposed track will cross an existing watercourse, 'West Cleugh' and little detail has been provided as to how the watercourse will be crossed by the proposed track.

I can confirm that there are no TPO, notable trees or hedgerows affected by the proposals and tree protection measures will not be necessary in this case.

From a landscape perspective this proposed development is in keeping with the forest environment in which it is set and I do not perceive that it will pose a significant effect upon the landscape character or views of this part of the National Park.

I have no objections to this proposed application but would welcome a bit more detail being provided in future applications relating to track design and construction, ie which of the FC 'Forestry Civil Engineering Specifications and Standards'. If you have any questions in respect to the points raised above or require further information please do not hesitate to get in touch.
