Dear Chris,

The Historic Environment Record has two entries relative to the application site boundary, the first describes the existing cottages "notable only in their being entirely built of hard igneous rock without even sandstone dressings" (HER 14742). It would appear that there is no justification for retaining these buildings on the grounds of architectural or historical interest.

The second (HER 896) describes the deserted medieval village of Antechester from a survey in the late 16th century, referred to as Thompson's Walls in the 17th century. The reference has been generated from documentary sources and no evidence exists for within the application boundary. Aerial photographs reveal little potential for deposits relating to the former medieval village to be harmed by the proposals.

From existing records it is therefore concluded that there are no objections to the scheme as set out in the plans provided, nor justification for any mitigation by condition.
