Details of Proposal

The Local Planning Authority has been consulted under the Electricity Act 1989 and the Overhead lines (Exemption) (England and Wales) Regulations 2009 for the rebuilding of 220 metres of existing overhead line with aerial bunched conductor (ABC) wire.

The proposed works would be undertaken within the village of Holystone.

Assessment

Policy Context

Part 15 Class B of the 2015 GPDO states that:

Development by statutory undertakers for the generation, transmission, distribution or supply of electricity for the purposes of their undertaking consisting of—

(a) the installation or replacement in, on, over or under land of an electric line and the construction of shafts and tunnels and the installation or replacement of feeder or service pillars or transforming or switching stations or chambers reasonably necessary in connection with an electric line:

constitutes permitted development, unless section 37(1) of the Electricity Act 1989 applies.

The Overhead Lines (Exemption)(England and Wales) Regulations 2009 state that Section 37(1) of the Electricity Act shall not apply in relation to development listed in the exemption regulations; as such, the proposal is considered to be permitted development and the Local Planning Authority can only object to the proposal on grounds of environmental impact.

Assessment

The Local Planning Authority has been consulted under the Electricity Act 1989 and the Overhead lines (Exemption) (England and Wales) Regulations 2009 for the rebuilding of 203 metres of existing overhead line with aerial bunched conductor (ABC) wire.

The proposed line would not appear as a new feature within the landscape, being a replacement of existing wires with proposed ABC wire. The proposals would be undertaken against the backdrop of surrounding dwellings and building within Holystone, thus reducing the visual impact of the line and poles from the wider landscape setting.

The proposed replacement line would not represent an unacceptable addition to the landscape being essentially replacements of an existing line, and consequently it is recommended no objections be raised.

Recommendation & Conditions

That the following representations are made:

Northumberland National Park Authority raises **no objection** to this notification and **does not** wish the Secretary of State to consider the application.
