Dear Mr. Gill,

Having received your application seeking prior notification for the siting of a shipping container (as previously discussed in October of last year), I have today undertaken a site visit to the land in order to ascertain the current status of this.

Having visited the site, I could not easily see evidence of the 500 trees which you state have been planted on the land, as set out in the written Statement provided. Please could you therefore provide clear evidence that development has commenced, ideally comprising a photograph of the planting and a plan showing where the trees have been planted.

As previously advised, if forestry has not commenced on the site, the Authority cannot consider this application under the prior notification procedure; you would instead be required to submit a full planning application for the container.

I look forward to hearing from you in due course.
