## Commentary

I note that this application has been withdrawn, but that there is an intention to resubmit by the applicant at a future date.

Public Protection has assessed the documents submitted relating to the current application to convert the redundant workshop and out-building into two one-bedroom holiday lets. The site has not been subject to a Contaminated Land Assessment: Screening Assessment.

If the applicant does re-submit this application then I would recommend that a Contaminated Land Screening Assessment is carried out in order to determine whether there have been any previous contaminative uses within the buildings to be developed. I enclose a copy of the screening assessment form which may be used.
