Application for determination whether prior approval of details is needed for forestry development under Schedule 2, Part 6 of The Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development Order) 2015 in respect of proposed installation of a 200 metre road extension Watergate Wark Hexham Northumberland

With reference to the above application reference **16NP0061**, Northumberland National Park Authority has determined, under its planning powers as specified in the application, that **prior approval is not required**.

The development should be carried out within a period of five years from the date of the application and constructed in accordance with the details submitted with the application.

Please note that this is not approval of plans under the Building Regulations or any other consents procedure.

You should also note that Wark Public Bridleway 23 runs almost parallel to the proposed road. The works must have no effect on accessing this route. No action should be undertaken to disturb the surface of the path, obstruct the path or in any way prevent or deter public use of the path without the necessary legal diversion or closure order having been made.
