Hi Chris,

I am aware of this application and of the archaeological sensitivity of this area. It is clear that the applicant must demonstrate awareness of this sensitivity in the application. Clear evidence of previous disturbance and restriction of the depth of trench to above this level would be helpful. Where this cannot be demonstrated, it should be possible to create a predictive model of archaeological remains drawing upon recent archaeological work (for example, on Roman roads in the area). This can be provided from desk-based resources (maps, photographs, plans, archaeological reports, forming the basis of this assessment).

Due to the sensitivity and in the absence of clarity over the extent of previous disturbance, it is likely that an archaeological watching brief of excavations will be required in order to observe and record any archaeologically significant finds which might have survived in this area.
