Dear Rebecca,

The proposal is situated within an area of high archaeological sensitivity, a 570ha Scheduled Monument "1021382 Ingram Farm: Prehistoric to Post Medieval settlement, agricultural and funerary remains." The archaeological features consist of former ridge and furrow cultivation associated with the medieval village of Ingram, which are likely to be impacted upon by the proposal. The wider landscape setting includes hillforts, settlements and burial cairns forming a rich archaeological landscape.

As the proposal is situated within a Scheduled Monument, consent from the Secretary of State, advised by Historic England, is likely to be required and Historic England should be contacted for their advice in this regard. This will require detail to be supplied on the method and type of construction. It is also desirable to appreciate how this building will impact upon the wider landscape, including the scale and height of the building and materials used in its construction.
