The proposal is for the erection of a small prefabricated wooden potting shed (6 feet x 6 feet) with pent roof sloping down from front to back. This will be placed within the curtilage of The Stables, Harbottle NE65 7DG which is a grade 2 Listed Building. It will be located in the vegetable patch of the property and screened from the road by an established evergreen Escalonia hedge, two apple trees and a dry stone wall, already in situ. The shed height at its maximum is 2.057 M and the shed base is 0.22 M below the level of the road. At its closest the shed is 3.5 M from the edge of the roadway
