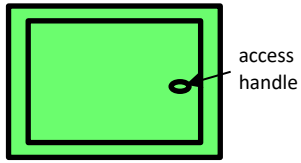
Note: This treatment plant is not on our land and we cannot monitor its maintenance or operation

Picture of a WPL HiPAF Package Treatment Plant with kiosk housing air blowers



Picture shows an almost identical HiPAF package treatment plant to that proposed for the campsite, to be located on our land as shown on the Site Plan (proposed). An identical kiosk housing the air blowers is also shown. The dimensions of this kiosk are shown on Document 2 – Plant Data (referred to as GRP enclosure) and are 1400 x 1100 x 1000 mm (width x length x height). Installation requires a concrete slab base of dimensions that exceed that of the kiosk by 200mm, length x width.

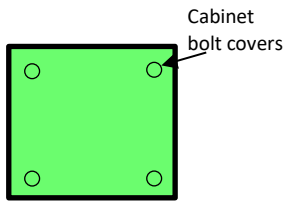

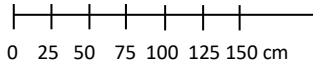
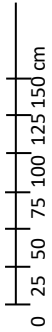
