Pub's function room— Install window and doors

Create a rear entrance and windows into the garden from the pub's function room



Pub's function room – Install window and doors

Create a rear entrance and a floor/ceiling window into the garden from the function room. Cut two openings in the stone and install a sliding patio door 3m wide and 2m high, and a 3 pane window 3m wide and 2m high, colour grey. The first opening will be doorway, the second windows.

The current photo of the garden is before landscaping which will remove soil to floor level in front of the building.





Living Accommodation – Install French door

Create a rear entrance into the garden for the pub's living accommodation



Living Accommodation – Install French door

Create a rear entrance into the garden from the pub's living accommodation. Cut an opening in the stone and install a French door 1m wide and 2m high, colour grey to blend with function room rear doors.

The current photo of the garden is before landscaping which will remove soil to floor level in front of the building.





Install solar panels to pub's roof Looking into courtyard



Install solar panels to pub's roof to save ££ on electricity including hot water.

The installation will be 14 310w panels in all black across two rows. As the roof is fairly shallow it is being treated as a domestic installation – panels installed within 1m of the edge.

There will be a small space approx. 2 panels in from the left to accommodate the woodburning flue.
