## Dear Colin,

I have no objection to the application in principle. The likelihood of archaeological remains being damaged as a result of the development is low given the scale of the development and the recent use of the site.

I note the comments of Building Conservation and agree that the use of stone as opposed to a rendered finish to be more in keeping with the local vernacular and this is significant given the cultural and historic significance of the group of former agricultural workers cottages, with the use of Welsh slate justified as a roofing material.

I have no issue with the construction of an ancillary building subject to the appropriate use of materials in keeping with the area's historic character, nor do I wish to object to the use of the land for growing of vegetables. It is likely that the original occupants would have access to a small plot in which to grow fruit and vegetables for domestic consumption.
