Dear Colin,

With reference to Consultee comments from Highways, I attach site plans of the area, showing access with visibility dimensions.

Please note that this is an existing access for parking and has been for some 100-150 years, to 2 no. properties. The marking in red over the entrance from cottages 1-2, are purely for planning criteria. The applicant does not own the driveway to the front of No. 2 (Mr. & Mrs. Carr) and has only right of access. It is stated that the entrance has to be widened, but the wall is not under the control to be removed and will not be allowed to be altered. Due to turning areas as shown, the exit from gardens will be forward direction only.

It is the intention to use Grasscrete up to the tarmac highway road, as shown on the attached and therefore with this material, there will be no gravel discharge or kerbing to provide natural landscape to this Listed area.
