Commentary

To protect the inherent darkness of the National Park it is integral to any planning approval granted that a condition is included to restrict the use of external amenity lighting. In accordance with Paragraph 180 of the NPPF and Policy DM11 of the Local Plan.

Recommended Conditions

Condition 1 - External Lighting

No unit hereby approved may operate any external lighting unless it is operated using a motion sensing system. This system will switch on when movement is detected and will switch off after a period of time when no movement is detected. The aforementioned period of time must not exceed five minutes.

Reason:

To limit the impact of light pollution from artificial light on local amenity, intrinsically dark landscapes and nature conservation

All recommended conditions above should be subject to confirmation by Development Services Legal Team, to ensure they are enforceable.
