# REPLACE THE EXISTING DECK WITH A NEW PRECAST BEAM AND SLAB DESIGN AND RESURFACING SWINDON KENNELS BRIDGE HEPPLE NORTHUMBERLAND NE65 7AP

Thank you for referring the above application which we received on 21 May 2025.

## **Environment Agency Position**

We have **NO OBJECTIONS** to the proposed development as submitted. However, we have the following comments/advice to offer:

## Flood risk

The development will not increase flood risk on or off site. There must be no reduction in the cross-sectional areas beneath the bridge as per the submitted plans.

## Fish - Advice to LPA/Applicant

Fish passage should be maintained at all times to ensure the works do not present a barrier to fish movement. Failure to maintain fish passage could result in committing an offense under Salmon and Freshwater Fisheries Act 1975 and the Eel Regulations 2009.

Any works within the water should be carried out between 1st June to 30th September to avoid sensitive period for migratory fish which is between 1st October and 31st May inclusive. This is to avoid disturbance to spawning fish and/or their habitat and eggs. If work is carried out outside this window there is a risk of committing an offence under the Salmon and Freshwater Fisheries Act 1975.

## Pollution Prevention - Advice to LPA/Applicant

Juvenile Lamprey are likely be present in the river sediments at this location and could be adversely impacted by any in-channel work. Any sediment excavated from the river edge should be left on the bank close to the water for a period of 24 hours to allow lamprey to return to the river. Any silt removed from in behind cofferdams should also be checked thoroughly for lamprey.
