Apologies for not responding to this consultation earlier. My comments with regard to this application are in principle similar to NP190056. The proposal has been carefully considered to reduce harm to the historic parkland, away from the principal views to and from the main house.

That the conclusions with regard to the level of harm are predicated upon the presence of 20th century plantation. Consideration of the effect should this be removed should be made. However, the siting of this proposal, in line with that of existing consented structures, would appear to reduce harm to the parkland setting and therefore there can be no reasonable objection.
