Approval of details reserved by conditions no 4 (construction environmental management plan), 5 (construction method statement), 6 (tree planting scheme) and 7 (track seeding scheme) of planning permission 18NP0006 - Installation of a 25m high lattice mast accommodating 3no. antennas and 2no. 600mm transmission dishes and associated ground based equipment.
