**18NP0081 Demolition of Existing Timber Clad Buildings and Shed and Construction of Replacement Single Storey Building at Vindolanda.**

Further to our email correspondence on 22<sup>nd</sup> July please find enclosed an application to formally vary condition number 2 of the above approved planning application following a change to the building design.

The revised building design has the same footprint as the previous approved proposal and is also designed to sit on the existing concrete pad and therefore requiring no foundations. The external finishing of the building is clad with UK sourced timber and the roof is a sedum green roof. These features contrast to the original zinc design and we consider these will further soften the impact of the new building in the landscape.
