Thank you for your letter of 16 August 2019 regarding the above application for planning permission. On the basis of the information available to date, we offer the following advice to assist your authority in determining the application.

## **Historic England Advice**

This application represents a change to the design of the building proposed by the applicant to this site, with all other details remaining as for the earlier proposal granted planning permission. In our view therefore:

- There are no significant below-ground archaeological issues associated with this
  proposal, as the approach taken is the same as for the earlier application, which
  is one of largely avoiding excavations
- The revised design would not change the impact of development here on the setting of Vindolanda and the World Heritage Site - by design, location and context it would avoid harm to the ability to understand and appreciate Roman military planning and land use

Recommendation

Historic England has no objection to the application on heritage grounds.
