Sorry for not responding sooner, it would be good practice to arrange for an archaeologist to observe the excavations relating to drainage works given the proximity of the site to the World Heritage Site.

A suitable condition might read “No work shall take place until the applicant has confirmed in writing that ground disturbing works will be monitored by a suitably qualified and experienced archaeologist. This watching brief should conform to the current standard and guidance of the Chartered Institute for Archaeologists, culminating in the production of a report approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority.”
