I can confirm that I have read through the report relating to the condition to be discharged. Clearly trench 1 has revealed a homogenous clay layer of glacial till and supports the conclusion that no archaeological deposits or features have been observed. As the condition is relevant to trench 1, the condition can be discharged.

It is disappointing that trenches 2 and 3, having been excavated, do not show homogenous deposits and although they are unlikely to reveal archaeological features or deposits, it would have been helpful had the natural deposits been more clearly illustrated in the report.
