Thank you for the comments received from Public Protection. We can confirm the following;

**Ground Gas** – Please note historical localized surface mine works are within the area but not in the immediate vicinity of the cottage. Ground protection to a CS2 standard will be installed to the kennel and bothy outbuildings as good practice. The existing house does not have a gas membrane installed, the floors are concrete and not easily upgraded therefore no gas membrane will be proposed to the existing house. Please confirm if you require any further information on this matter?

**Water supply** – To confirm the site obtains water supply from High Green Estate from a natural spring. Based on the response from public protection it is not clear what is required of the risk assessment, can you please provide a scoping document and clarification of what is required to meet the requirements of public protection?
