Further to the concerns expresseing in my email of the 28<sup>th</sup> March with regards to the above application the Parish Council has had further fed back.

There is no enthusiasm amongst those near this proposed development for the following reasons:

- The national park will not grant permission to construct a new second home in the Nat. Park – and one of these 2 proposed dwellings is destined to be used as a 2nd home.
- The application is for the construction of holiday cottages – this is very misleading.
- The wall and roofing materials appear to be cheap and unsympathetic with the surrounding existing properties .
