Comments from 20NP0002LBC from 23/01/2020

I have looked at the addendum to the bat survey for this site (and the original survey report). Over the years in the recent bat surveys no bats have been observed roosting in this area and it is believed that the roosts in the other buildings will not be affected by the proposed works. No EPS licence for this work is therefore required. It is however recommended that works are undertaken according with a precautionary method statement, including an endoscope check of the small number of crevices within the arrow slit windows prior to removal, and avoiding the hibernation period (mid Nov to end Feb) since there are bats known on site. If this is made a condition I have no objections to the LBC.
