

## **12524 Beeswing, Elsdon, Otterburn, Northumberland NE19 1AP Design and Access Statement**

### 01. Introduction

This Design and Access Statement has been produced to assist in the understanding of the scheme as part of the householder planning application. Read in conjunction with the associated drawings package and supporting documentation, it is hoped that it will outline the design and approach taken to assist in the understanding of the scheme in the context of the proposal.

### 02. Site, Use and Background

The existing house and associated gardens form part of an existing holiday let property for the applicant

The existing buildings are of traditional natural stone construction with natural slate roofing.

The existing site forms part of the existing farmland. The site has moderately level topography.

### 03. Design Statement

The original proposal is to construct a single-story side and rear extension to modernise the existing property bring it in line with current demands and industry standards. The application for this proposal was submitted and approved previously (application reference: 19NP0004).

The current proposal, for which this additional application is for, is to install a replacement oil tank in a new location. The reason for the new location, is to ensure that access to the tank is more appropriate, safer and easier for deliveries. The new location also means that the tank isn't in the first line of sight when arriving at the property, which is important due to this being a holiday let.

### 04. Appearance, Materials and Construction

It is proposed that the additions will be constructed from the building materials as follows:

Tank - Plastic

Fencing - Timber
