Hi Margaret, hope your well. Thanks for your email, in answer to you questions :-

The total farm area is 960 acres

The papers attached with the pre app are for the poly tunnel we propose.

The stockboard is in place of mesh sides as this would be unsuitable for horned ewes. The stockboard comes in 8ft by 4ft pieces so it would be no more than 4ft high.
