Thank you or consulting me on this application. I have read the ecological survey and protected species reports and have the following comments:

No bats were found roosting in the bridge despite activity in the area, so no licence or mitigation is required for these protected species. Otters and potentially white clawed crayfish could be present therefore I recommend making the mitigation listed in section 5 of Total Ecology Protected Species report (dated October 2020) a condition. This covers actions pre works as well as working methodologies to prevent disturbance and pollution. This would also protect the river against pollution incidents as well.

If these measures are made a condition I do not have any objections to the application.
