Erection of two adjoining poly tunnel structures for the purpose of lambing sheep at East Twice Brewed, Causey View, Bardon Mill, Northumberland NE47 7AL

Thank you for consulting with Historic England on the planning application (20NP0089). The area proposed for the lambing polytunnel is within the buffer-zone of the Hadrian's Wall World Heritage Site (WHS), and very close to areas of Scheduled Ancient Monument. As such the setting of the Scheduled area has been considered in this case.

I believe the proposed position, with the farm-buildings to the west, and the trees to the north and east, means that the impact on the setting of the monument will be minimal. Equally, as this is a temporary structure (the manufacturer gives a life-span of up to 10-years), any localised impact will be minimal. Considering the nature of the development, and the agricultural nature of location, it is my conclusion that this development will not adversely affect the setting of the Scheduled Ancient Monument or WHS buffer-zone.

Thus, Historic England will not be objecting to the proposal.
