Thank you for sending through the application for additional lighting at The Sill. Having looked at the plans and the specification of the lights being considered, I have the following comments to make to ensure the best results for our dark skies:

Erco Castor Bollard – I recommend the 500mm high version with the 16w/1680 lumen, 3000k bulb (see attached)

Simes Mircroreef Bollard – I recommend the 'Microreef with grid' version with 11w/760 lumen, 3000k bulb

Simes Miniloft Wall light – this is an excellent light, and has been proven to be both effective and appropriate for the dark sky park.
