Public Health Protection Unit (PHPU) technically objects to this application regarding the following concerns:

Noise and Odour from the Kitchen Extraction Ventilation (KEV).

Object Re: Noise & Odour Impact on the Locality and amities of the Area.

We would recommend that the Northumberland National Planning Authority (NNPA) **object** to this proposal on the grounds of insufficient information regarding to the potential impact of noise and odour upon the sensitive receptors that live in close proximity to the proposed restaurant.

In the case of commercial kitchens, the noise generated from kitchen activities and any extract ventilation can be audible locally.

Similarly, untreated objectionable and offensive odours can cause significant adverse effect on neighbours and the general locality or the area

PHPU object to this application as the applicant has not submitted a noise or an odour risk assessment regarding to the impact of the kitchen extraction ventilation (KEV) upon sensitives receptors.

PHPU would wish to be re consulted on this application when the applicant has

submitted a Noise and Oduor assessment report.
