Many thanks for consulting me on the proposed covering of muck store at East Todholes Farm.

I have been working closely with the applicants on their new Higher Tier Countryside Stewardship scheme. The covering of the muck store is part of the scheme and a series of environmental improvements for the wider farm. The existing muck store is exposed to the elements, thus muck is mixing with rain water creating dirty water run-off. Covering the muck store with a roof will significantly reduce this problem.

The proposed structure is with the existing yard footprint and the design appears to be in in keeping with the existing cattle shed.

Therefore, with the above in mind, I have no objections to the application from a Farming Officer point of view.

In addition, I welcome the plan for dark sky sensitive lighting.
