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Dear Colin,

I note since my last response some details have been updated on this application and some details regarding hedges, individual trees and some bird provision have been added. Although these are welcome I still think for a development of this size there is not enough. There has been no addition of details to address increased run off and no real additional landscaping such as ponds or wetland areas to take-up the additional run-off. I suggest that since the properties could be built individually and not all at the same time, that the overall scheme and individual plot details are agreed by a condition. Each house should have bat and bird provision and the native hedges included. Ash trees as shown on the plans are not suitable for planting at this time.

As mentioned in my previous reply there also needs to be a pollution prevention scheme/mitigation scheme. I suggest that we make it a condition that this is provided and agreed before the first property is built.

If we could add these conditions I do not object to the application.
